THE WOODCHURCH 10 & 5 MILE RUN

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2020

To allow The Woodchurch 10 & 5 Mile Run to take place on and near the highway, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on sections of Bethersden Road and Front Road, Woodchurch, near Tenterden.

A closure of Bethersden Road and Front Road is planned for Sunday 18 October 2020 from 08:30 hours to 11:30 hours, with the closure lifted as soon as it is safe to do so.

Bethersden Road will be closed between the junction with Shadoxhurst Road to where it becomes Front Road, which in turn will be closed as far as the junction with Lower Road.

The alternative route for through traffic is via Shadoxhurst Road, Spot House Lane, Place Lane and Lower Road.

Personnel will be on site to allow managed access for residents when it is safe to do so, but there are likely to be delays and certain times when this is not possible for safety reasons.
