BETHERSDEN ROAD, SMARDEN, ASHFORD

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

To allow works to be carried out to provide a new water connection, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Bethersden Road, Smarden, in the Ashford area.

A closure is currently planned from Monday 15 February 2021, with estimated completion by 19 February 2021.

Bethersden Road will be closed in the general vicinity of the property 'Peniel', with no through access between the junctions with Luckhurst Lane and Buffalo Lane.

The alternative route for through traffic is via Biddenden Road, The Cut, Smarden Road, A262 Headcorn Road, High Halden Road, North Street, Tenterden Road, High Halden Road, Pot Kiln Lane and Smarden Road back to Bethersden Road.

Local access to the remainder of Bethersden Road continues from either direction up to where the road is actually closed.

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons including the current coronavirus situation, and updated information can be found on www.one.network – [South East Water Permit EB006-25518649], with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
