**A28 ASHFORD ROAD,
BETHERSDEN, ASHFORD**

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

To allow essential carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of A28 Ashford Road, Bethersden, near Ashford.

Overnight closures are planned from Tuesday 27 April 2021 for up to 3 nights, from 19:30 hours through until approximately 05:00 hours each night.

A28 ASHFORD ROAD will be closed in the general vicinity of the junction with Forge Hill, to the actual extent shown on site.

~ There will be no direct access between Ashford and Tenterden during these closures ~

The alternative route for all through traffic is via A28 Ashford Road, Church Hill, Woodchurch Road, Plurenden Road and Bethersden Road back to A28 Ashford Road, and vice versa.

FORGE HILL will be closed at the junction with A28 Ashford Road, with access to the remainder of Forge Hill continuing from a northern direction via A28 Ashford Road, School Road, Church Hill and The Street.

Personnel will be on site to allow managed access for residents and businesses when it is safe to do so, but there are likely to be delays and certain times when this is not possible for safety reasons

Local access to the remainder of A28 Ashford Road continues from either direction up to where the road is actually closed.

The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons including the current coronavirus situation and adverse weather conditions, with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
