POT KILN LANE, BETHERSDEN, ASHFORD

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

To allow telegraph pole replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Pot Kiln Lane, Bethersden, near Ashford.

A closure is currently planned for Thursday 13 May 2021 between 08:00 hours and approximately 18:00 hours.

Pot Kiln Lane will be closed in the general vicinity of Quilters Cottage / Potteries Farm, to the actual extent shown on site.

The alternative route for through traffic is via High Halden Road, Harris Lane, Thurstons Lane, Cripple Hill, A28 Ashford Road and Bull Lane back to Pot Kiln Lane, and vice versa.

Local access to the remainder of Pot Kiln Lane continues from either direction up to where the road is actually closed.

The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons including the current coronavirus situation and adverse weather conditions, with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
