PLUCKLEY ROAD, SMARDEN, ASHFORD

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

To allow works to be carried out to provide a new electricity supply, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Pluckley Road, Smarden, in the Ashford area.

A closure is currently planned from Monday 26 July 2021, with estimated completion by 30 July 2021.

Pluckley Road will be closed between the junctions with Glebe Close and Mill Lane, to the actual extent shown on site.

The alternative route for all through traffic is via The Street, Cage Lane, Bethersden Road and Romden Road back to Pluckley Road.

Local access to the remainder of Pluckley Road continues from either direction up to where the road is actually closed.

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons including the current coronavirus situation and adverse weather conditions, with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
