**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)**

**TEMPORARY ORDER 2021**

**To allow works to be carried out to provide a new fibre connection, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Vitters Oak Lane, Bethersden, near Ashford.**

**An off-peak closure is currently planned for Wednesday 28 July 2021 between 09:30 hours and approximately 15:30 hours.**

**Vitters Oak Lane will be closed between the junctions with Old Surrenden Manor Road and Park Lane to the actual extent shown on site.**

**The alternative route for through traffic is via Old Surrenden Manor Road, A28 Ashford Road and Sandy Lane back to Vitters Oak Lane.**

**The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons, with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.**
