THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER MAY 2024

South East Water works.

To allow new connection works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to impose temporary mandatory speed restrictions of 30 mph and 50 mph on part of the A28 Ashford Road, Bethersden.

The restrictions are planned from 28th May 2024, with estimated completion by 2nd June 2024, or where stated on a valid Permit (EB009-37639372-1-01 - South East Water). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

The temporarily mandatory speed restrictions will be imposed on part of the A28 Ashford Road as follows:-

Through traffic shall be temporarily prohibited from travelling at a speed greater than 30 mph between Lanover Lodge and Lencroft, to the actual extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

Through traffic shall be temporarily prohibited from travelling at a speed greater than 50 mph between Burnt Oak and Weald Cottage, to the actual extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

Two way lights with a chicane will also be in place between Lanover Lodge and Lencroft.

The restrictions are required for the safety of the public and workforce while new connection works are undertaken by South East Water.
