South East Water works.

To allow water pipe repair works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Standard Lane, Bethersden.

A closure is planned from 19th May 2025, with estimated completion by 21st May 2025, or where stated on a valid Permit (EB00658023940-01 - South East Water). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Standard Lane will be closed in the vicinity of Three Gables, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while water pipe repair works are undertaken by South East Water.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Standard Lane, Chequer Tree Lane, Gascoigne Road, A28 Ashford Road and vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
