THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER JULY 2025

Kent County Council works.

To allow carriageway works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of A28 Ashford Road, Tenterden.

A closure is planned from 14th July 2025, with estimated completion by 11th August 2025, between the hours of 20:00 and 05:00, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE70532491014-02 - Kent County Council). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

A28 Ashford Road will be closed between the junctions with A262 Biddenden Road and Grange Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while carriageway works are undertaken by Kent County Council.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via A28 Ashford Road, High Street, West Cross, Rolvenden Road, Cranbrook Road, Tenterden Road, Benenden Road, A262 Tenterden Road and Biddenden Road.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
