TEMPORARY ORDER JULY 2025

The Electricity Network Company Limited works.

To allow installation works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Tuesnoad Lane, Bethersden.

A closure is planned from 28th July 2025, with estimated completion by 2nd August 2025, or where stated on a valid Permit (N50122411030-168047-02 - The Electricity Network Company Limited). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Tuesnoad Lane will be closed outside number 1 and 2, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while installation works are undertaken by The Electricity Network Company Limited.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Wissenden Lane, Wissenden Green and vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
