TEMPORARY ORDER MARCH 2026

South East Water works.

To allow defect works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Old Surrenden Manor Road, Bethersden.

A closure is planned from 16th March 2026, with estimated completion by 17th March 2026, or where stated on a valid Permit (EB00628716867-04 - South East Water). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Old Surrenden Manor Road will be closed in the vicinity of Beult Farm Yard, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while defect works are undertaken by South East Water.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Old Surrenden Manor Road, Mill Road, Forge Hill, A28 Ashford Road, Old Surrenden Manor Road and vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
