OPENREACH LIMITED works.

To allow pole and cabling works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Tuesnoad Lane, Bethersden.

A closure is planned from 24th June 2026 with estimated completion by 25th June 2026, between the hours of 08:00 and 17:00, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC411001WGNT3L2D-01 - OPENREACH LIMITED). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Tuesnoad Lane will be closed approximately 300m east of number 3, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while pole and cabling works are undertaken by OPENREACH LIMITED.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Tuesnoad Lane, Wissenden Green, Wissenden Lane and vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
