TEMPORARY ORDER AUGUST 2026**

South East Water works.

To allow water connection works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Bethersden Road, Bethersden.

A closure is planned from 1st August 2026, with estimated completion by 3rd August 2026, or where stated on a valid Permit (EB009B1554-2-01 - South East Water). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Bethersden Road will be closed in the vicinity of Snoad Hill Farm, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while water connection works are undertaken by South East Water.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Bethersden Road, Sparrow Hatch Lane, Dowle Street Road, Station Road, End Of Pluckley Road At River Beult To Chambers Green Road, Station Approach, Pluckley Road, Fridd Lane and vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
