OPENREACH LIMITED works.

To allow pole and cabling works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Bull Lane, Bethersden.

A closure is planned from 22nd July 2026, with estimated completion by 23rd July 2026, between the hours of 08:00 and 17:00, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC411001WGRW2R4G-02 - OPENREACH LIMITED). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Bull Lane will be closed opposite The Glebe, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while pole and cabling works are undertaken by OPENREACH LIMITED.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Bull Lane, Smarden Road, Bethersden Road, Cage Lane, The Street, Pluckley Road, Chambers Green Road, End Of Pluckley Road At River Beult To Chambers Green Road, Mill Road, Forge Hill, Ashford Road and vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
