TEMPORARY ORDER OCTOBER 2026**

Openreach works.

To allow installation works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Fridd Lane, Bethersden.

A closure is planned from 7th October 2026, with estimated completion by 9th October 2026, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC411001WH4J336J-01 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Fridd Lane will be closed in the vicinity of Mill Hill Farm business units, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while installation works are undertaken by Openreach.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Old Surrenden Manor Road, A28 Ashford Road, Goldwell Lane, Etchden Road and Fridd Lane.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
