**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER OCTOBER 2026**

Openreach works.

To allow pole testing works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Old Surrenden Manor Road, Bethersden.

A closure is planned from 15th October 2026 for up to one day, between the hours of 09:30 and 15:30, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC008WH4JN89ZPTSB-02 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Old Surrenden Manor Road will be closed between the entrance to the industrial park and Old Surrenden Manor Bungalows heading 1540m to A28 Ashford Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while pole testing works are undertaken by Openreach.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via A28 Ashford Road, Forge Hill, Mill Road, Old Surrenden Manor Road and vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
